AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

BRITTANY WILLIAMS and MAC BLOOM, Deputy County Attorneys, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and say:

We have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of Eduardo Lopez for allegedly committing the offenses of COUNT I: NEGLIGENT HOMICIDE, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-104 COUNT II: CRIMINAL ENDANGERMENT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-207 COUNT III: CRIMINAL ENDANGERMENT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-207 COUNT IV: CRIMINAL

ENDANGERMENT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-

207 COUNT V: CRIMINAL ENDANGERMENT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-207 COUNT VI: CRIMINAL ENDANGERMENT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-207 COUNT VII: CRIMINAL ENDANGERMENT, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Based upon the following facts which have been obtained from reports of the law enforcement officer which, if true, constitute sufficient probable cause to justify the filing of the charges. The facts from those reports are as follows:

On October 25, 2017, at approximately 5:51 a.m., Missoula 911 Dispatch began receiving calls regarding a wrong-way driver on Interstate 90. Six different complainants reported that a white truck was travelling eastbound in the westbound lanes. The driver of the wrong way truck, later identified as Eduardo Lopez, reportedly entered Interstate 90 somewhere near the Van Buren Street exit. One complainant, Nick Gallagher, who was travelling eastbound on the correct (eastbound) side of the Interstate, paced alongside Lopez's truck. Gallagher reported that Lopez was travelling approximately seventy-five miles per hour in the westbound passing lane and did not seem to notice that he was going the wrong way. Several minutes later, Gallagher informed Dispatch that a westbound vehicle had pulled into the passing lane to get around a semi-truck and was struck head-on by Lopez.

Trooper Parks, Montana Highway Patrol, arrived on the crash scene and observed a burning Toyota Highlander—the vehicle Lopez struck. The driver of the Highlander,

Shawna Wootan, was deceased. Deputy Von Gontard, Missoula County Sheriff's Office, also on scene, pulled Lopez out of his truck in order to protect him from the fire. Lopez was transported to St. Patrick Hospital. Trooper Parks then observed a third vehicle, a white sedan driven by John Babbitt, that had gone off the roadway. Babbitt's sedan had been struck by Lopez's wheel assembly. He reacted by swerving to the right. As he left the roadway, Babbitt struck a delineator post and coasted down an embankment.

Sergeant Finley responded to St. Patrick Hospital and read Lopez the Implied Consent advisory. Lopez agreed to provide a blood sample for testing. A phlebotomist withdrew Lopez's blood and the sample was submitted for toxicological analysis. Trooper Palmer interviewed Lopez. Lopez stated that prior to the crash he left the Red Lion Hotel was attempting to return to the La Quinta. He admitted to consuming alcohol the previous evening.

Trooper Smart conducted interviews of seven additional victims who had nearly been struck by Lopez. They reported having to take evasive maneuvers to avoid collisions. They explained that they feared that a crash with Lopez would have cost them their lives.
