AFFIDAVIT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

JORDAN KILBY, Deputy County Attorney, Montana, being first duly sworn upon oath, deposes and says:

I have read the official law enforcement reports regarding the investigation of Paul Lewis Ekstedt for allegedly committing the offenses of COUNT I: ASSAULT WITH WEAPON, a Felony, in violation of Montana law, namely: Mont. Code Ann. 45-5-213.

Based upon the following facts which have been obtained from reports of the law enforcement officer which, if true, constitute sufficient probable cause to justify the filing of the charges. The facts from those reports are as follows:

On June 14, 2018 at approximately 6:05 p.m., Missoula City Police Officers responded to the 1500 block of South 7th Street in Missoula County for the report of a

physical disturbance. Dispatch advised one male hit another in the head with a baseball bat.

Sgt. Hebert responded to the reported residence and made contact with witnesses and the victim, Gary Fuller. One witness stated she, Gary and another person were leaving the residence in route to go eat dinner. She stated Paul then struck Gary in the back of the head with a baseball bat he obtained from the kitchen. She reported there had not been any argument between Gary and Paul prior to this, but Paul had been acting strange for the last week and a half. She stated Paul was Paul Ekstedt and that she was in a relationship with him.

Another witness stated she was seated in a chair facing the entrance to the home and she witnessed the attack. She stated Gary, the above witness and another were leaving to go eat. She stated the three were walking out the door when Paul grabbed the bat and struck Gary in the head. This witness stated when Gary was struck he immediately fell to the floor. Sgt. Hebert observed Gary to be in pain on the couch and holding his head. He was conscious, but unable to answer any questions. Gary was transported to St. Patrick Hospital where he has undergone surgery.

Paul was apprehended nearby. Officers observed him to be under an unknown intoxicating substance and acting strangely. He was not cooperative with the investigation. DATED this 15th day of June, 2018.
