ALL ENTRIES: if not received by 5PM Sunday, Aug 29

will be charged a \$20 late fee. Late entries will be accepted

IF they can be accommodated.

RIDERS MAY NOT COMPETE UNLESS: 1) Entry fees paid in full (checks may be open or dated day of show and will be held. **Make checks** payable K-9 SAR Support Group),

2) Entry form is completed and signed and 3) proof of negative coggins test dated within 12 months of show & vaccination record for horses not boarded at Holly Hill Farm. Late fees will be enforced!

**Refund Policy**

**Schooling** 

Unsafe conduct & over crowding will NOT be tolerated.
Longeing is NOT permitted in either arena at any time.

Hunter courses may be schooled on Friday and before 7:45 AM Saturday.

Jumper courses will not be schooled beforehand.

All day warm up in the covered arena. Please limit number of horses for safety to six at one time.

#### **Class Cancellations**

"Over fence" hunter & jumper classes will be run with only one rider. "Under saddle" hunter classes must have a minimum of 3 riders. If the "under saddle" class of a hunter division is canceled then that division Championship and Reserve Championship awards are not presented. List of canceled classes can be obtained at the Secretary's desk and will be announced.

**Pet Policy** 

All pets must be kept on a leash (no longer than 6 feet) at all times when on the show grounds (arena, spectator area, concession, office, stabling and warm-up areas).

Barking dogs must be removed! All pets are the responsibility of their owners.

KEEP YOUR DOG AWÂY FROM CRATED DOGS!

PLEASE do not approach the score boards or concession area mounted or with your horse on lead. There are children playing in this area as well as leashed dogs and this is an unsafe practice.

#### **JUMPER CLASSES**

USEF Table 2.11.b. (JUMP OFF ROUND CLASS) If rider goes clean in the first round (upon an audible signal and without leaving the ring) rider starts the designated jump off course. Least faults, fastest time wins. First round may also be timed making it possible to break the ties of horses with four faults.

UESF Table 2.11.C (**POWER AND SPEED CLASS**) Rider must jump first round clean and upon crossing the finish line of the power part, timer starts and rider continues immediately to the jump off course, the speed part.

USEF Table 2.1.A (**OPTIMUM TIME / SPEED CLASS**) Optimum time is defined as 4 secs less Time Allowed for 382 yds /min. Rider closest to Optimum Time (without going over) with the least faults will prevail. Faults will be scored under Table II.

PRE CHILD /ADULT EQUITATION DIV - Open to all Junior and Adult Amateur riders. Rider may not enter where fences are 3' or higher at this show. Fence height 2'3"

MODIFIED CHILD / ADULT EQUITATION DIV- Open to all junior and adult amateur riders. Riders may not cross enter into classes with fences 3'3" or higher. Fence heights 2'6" – 2'9"
