CLASSES and DIVISIONS Descriptions and Requirements

SATURDAY APRIL 2, 2022

Hunter Outdoor Arena: Starting at 8:30 AM

Warm up in Indoor Arena

Walk Trot Division Open to riders 18 & under judged on equitation. May be asked to walk/trot, halt and/or back, figure 8, 2 point position over poles or answer questions regarding basic horsemanship, tack or confirmation.

- Class #1 Walk Trot Equitation
- Class #2 Walk Trot Hunter Under Saddle
- Class #3 Walk Trot Horsemanship

All Day Hunter Warm Up Class Class #4 Open card class, rider must inform paddock entering ring.

Poles On Ground Division Riders 18 & under show over a course consisting of 4" dia poles on the ground.

- Class #5 Poles On Ground Over Fences Course 1
- Class #6 Poles On Ground Over Fences Course 2
- Class #7 Poles On Ground Under Saddle Class

Beginner Hunter Division Open to horses that do not jump higher than 2'6" at this show. X rails ridden at the trot or canter. Fence heights 18" (Judge may split class walk / trot / canter and walk / trot)

- Class #8 Beginner Hunter Over Fences Course 1
- Class #9 Beginner Hunter Over Fences Course 2
- Class #10 Beginner Hunter Under Saddle

Lead Line Class Rider/horse presented before the judge and may be shown on a lead or independent.

- Class LL Rider/horse presented before the judge and may be shown on a lead or independent.

Short / Long Stirrup Hunter Division Open to all horses. No oxers. Fence hts 2'

- Class #11 Short / Long Stirrup Hunter Over Fences Course 1
- Class #12 Short/ Long Stirrup Hunter Over Fences Course 2
- Class #13 Short / Long Stirrup Hunter Under Saddle Class

Happy Hunter Division Open to all horses. Fence heights 2'3"-2'6"

- Class #14 Happy Hunter Over Fences Course 1
- Class #15 Happy Hunter Over Fences Course 2
- Class #16 Happy Hunter Under Saddle Class

Young Hunter Division Open to horses five years of age or younger. Fence heights 2'3"-2'6"

- Class # 17 Young Hunter Over Fences Course 1
- Class # 18 Young Hunter Over Fences Course 2
- Class # 19 Young Hunter Under Saddle Class

Schooling Hunter Division Open to all horses. Fences 2'6"

- Class #20 Schooling Hunter Over Fences Course 1
- Class #21 Schooling Hunter Over Fences Course 2
- Class #22 Schooling Hunter Under Saddle Class

Modified Hunter Division Open to all horses Fences 2'9"-3'

- Class #23 Modified Hunter Over Fences Course 1

- Class #25 Modified Hunter Under Saddle Class

SUNDAY APRIL 3, 2022

Jumpers in Outdoor Ring 8:30 am Warm up Indoor Arena

there will be no schooling of the jumper course

Jumper courses at each level to consist of USEF table 2.11.b, table 2.11c and table 2.1a in this order:
Riders must enter 3 classes to be eligible for Championship and Reserve Championship

USEF Table 2.11.b. (**JUMP OFF ROUND CLASS**) If rider goes clean in the first round (upon an audible signal and without leaving the ring) rider starts the designated jump off course. Least faults, fastest time wins. First round may also be timed making it possible to break the ties of horses with four faults.

UESF Table 2.11.C (**POWER AND SPEED CLASS**) Rider must jump first round clean and upon crossing the finish line of the power part, timer starts and rider continues immediately to the jump off course, the speed part.

USEF Table 2.1.A (**OPTIMUM TIME / SPEED CLASS**) Optimum time is defined as 4 secs less Time Allowed for 382 yds /min. Rider closest to Optimum Time (and not over) with the least faults will prevail. Faults scored under Table II.

Class # 40 Level 2 Jumper Optimum Time / Speed Class

Level 3 Jumper Division Fences 3'3"-3'6" Spreads 3'6"
Class #41 Level 3 Jumper Jump Off Round Class
Class #42 Level 3 Jumper Power and Speed Class
Class #43 Level 3 Jumper Optimum Time / Speed Class

I also understand that dogs are the responsibility of their owners and are to be restrained on show grounds either by cages or six foot leashes but may not be tied in the stabling or show areas. I also understand it is the responsibility of the rider / guardian to enter only classes for which the rider and horse are capable.
