# **ELIGIBILITY AND REQUIREMENTS**

To be eligible to apply for The Ride for Change College Scholarship, an applicant must meet the following qualifications:

- A. Be a minority
- B. Be enrolled in a high school for the current year.
- C. Be a current year graduating Senior.
- D. Must have at least 30 hours of community service.
- E. Have a minimum of at least an eighty (80) GPA for the first three and one-half (3.5) years of high school.
- F. Submit a copy of the student's transcript for the first three and one-half (3.5) years of the student's high school career.
- G. Submit a typed, fully completed application by April 15th, 2021.
- H. Recipients must enroll in a college, university or technical school the fall semester following their graduation from high school.
- I. Scholarship monies will be distributed to the financial aid officer of the college, university or technical school of the recipient upon Townsquare Media and The Ride for Change receiving verification of enrollment in the fall semester.

### POLICIES AND SELECTION PROCEDURE

- 1. Recipient of the funds for the scholarship will be determined by Townsquare Media, The Ride for Change and its affiliate sponsors. The monetary amount of Amarillo's scholarship is \$300.00. We will be awarding one scholarship of this amount.
- 2. The Scholarship Selection Committee will consist of no less than three (3) and no more than five (5) voting members and will include The Ride for Change personnel and supporting sponsors.
- 3. All eligible Senior students enrolled in High School will be offered a Scholarship application.
- All eligible applications of students will then be turned over to the Scholarship Selection 4. Committee to be reviewed.
- Selection of the Scholarship winner will be made prior to the recipient's graduation, 5. where the recipient will be recognized.
- Scholarship monies will be distributed to the college, university or technical school of 6. each recipient upon the Townsquare Media Amarillo business office receiving verification of enrollment in the fall semester the year following graduation.
