

## June 6, 2015 – Blue Knights® La XIV Black Pot Cook-Off Rules and Regulations

- 1. Black pot anything goes cook-off. As long as it is prepared on site and cooked in a black pot, you may enter a team.
- 2. Grounds available for set up and to begin cooking any time before 9am.
- 3. No entry fee required to participate. All proceeds to benefit the family of Bronston Drew (a Crowley P.D. Officer who lost his home to a fire).
- 4. Food serving will begin promptly at 11:00am and end at 1:00pm.
- 5. A \$5 fee and arm band are required to eat.
- 6. Each team is responsible for their tents, bowls, cups, and utensils.
- 7. Cajun Harley-Davidson will not provide ice or water and only non-electrical equipment will be allowed.
- 8. All cooking must be done on site. Nothing can be pre-cooked except rice. Meat may be seasoned/marinated, but must be raw. Onions, peppers, etc. may be pre chopped.
- 9. Judging will begin promptly at 11am. Award ceremony will begin at 1:00pm. (Trophies will be awarded to 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place and People's Choice)
- 10. Each team will be responsible for keeping their area clean. Please clean up your area once the event is over.
