This year's Ryan Allen Guidry Memorial Golf Tournament will begin its 6th annual event on August 5, 2017. We hope to see all alumnae and new participants that are taking part in this wonderful event. For the past five years, the RAG golf tournament proceeds have been used to benefit a Lafayette High senior on his/her quest of entering college. This tournament has exceeded expectations all five years and we cannot thank all those who have participated in playing, donating and volunteering enough for their contributions. This year, we will continue to represent a student of Ryan Allen Guidry's alma mater but have also decided to benefit another important cause.

In the late Fall of 2016, the Lafayette community was hit with the heart breaking news of one our dearest friends being diagnosed with a desmoplastic medulloblastoma (malignant brain tumor). Trae Fitzgerald, who was a former outstanding graduate of the University of Louisiana at Lafayette, realized something was not right when he began having consistent headaches during Thanksgiving break. It was then known after visiting with a specialist that he would need to undertake an immediate procedure to remove an apparent brain tumor. Since then, Trae has undergone a successful six weeks at MD Anderson in Houston, receiving proton therapy radiation. Trae is currently undergoing chemo therapy at Acadiana Cancer Center.

Because of Trae's personal relation to those who support this event every year, and his past friendship with the late Ryan Guidry, the RAG proceeds were initially going to go towards the Fitzgerald family to help benefit the cost of the proton therapy. The Fitzgeralds then reached out to the committee with a different approach. Trae and his wife, Naomie, have decided to pass this blessing on another patient from MD Anderson that is in a dire situation. The Fitzgeralds, as they have done all through their years together, continue to put others before themselves, no matter the circumstances. Due to their selfless generosity, the RAG golf tournament proceeds will benefit another patient from MD Anderson, one who is going through a very similar situation as Trae but could not receive all the love and support that this community has already shown Trae. We are currently working with charitable coordinators at the MD Anderson Proton Therapy Research Center on identifying a patient that is in dire need of the funds to help undergo such treatment. We will recognize he/she by the time of the golf event to make all aware of who we are benefitting.

With your support and generosity we hope you join us again on August 5, 2017 for another joyous event.
