Subject: SEXUAL ASSAULT

On 11-21-13 between 0230 and 0300 hours known suspect, Darren Sharper, allegedly sexually assaulted two victims, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] at The [REDACTED] apartment complex [REDACTED] Tempe. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] went out for the evening and had a few drinks before going back to [REDACTED] apartment. [REDACTED] stated she was given a shot of alcohol by Sharper and that was the last thing she remembered. [REDACTED] woke up on the couch and went home to her parents house before realizing she believed she had been sexually assaulted. [REDACTED] returned to the apartment to confront Sharper before going to Tempe Saint Luke's Hospital to be examined. [REDACTED] was initially interviewed at Tempe Saint Luke's Hospital and then transported to the Mesa SANE Clinic location for a SANE exam. Officer Milczewsky interviewed and transported [REDACTED] to Scottsdale SANE office. At the time of this report Sharper has not been contacted or interviewed regarding this incident.

On 11-21-13 at approximately 1356 hours I was dispatched to 1500 S. Mill Ave, Tempe Saint Luke's Hospital, for a sexual assault that occurred several hours earlier in the day. Call notes stated that a female was claiming that she was drugged and forced to have sex. The caller stated that she had suspect information. The victim stated she did not have an exact apartment number but knew that it was [REDACTED] complex located at [REDACTED] Tempe. The caller stated that there was another female present and both victim's were currently seeking treatment at Tempe Saint Lukes hospital located at 1500 S Mill Ave, Tempe, Room #1. The caller was listed as being an Emergency Room nurse, Renee Little.

Upon my arrival at Tempe Saint Lukes located at 1500 S Mill Ave, Tempe I spoke with [REDACTED], who stated she believed she had been drugged and sexually assaulted. Investigation revealed that [REDACTED] friend [REDACTED] also was allegedly drugged and sexually assaulted at her apartment. During the investigation it was [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] roommate, [REDACTED] also believed she was drugged but had locked her bedroom door when she went to bed and was not sexually assaulted.

This incident allegedly occurred [REDACTED]



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which is the apartment in which both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] live. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] did not have any other roommates and reside there together in separate bedrooms. A fourth female, [REDACTED] had been with the other three females earlier in the evening but had left the apartment before either of the alleged sexual assaults occurred.

The following is a summary from the digitally recorded interview I conducted of victim [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated she was going to go out for the evening with some friends and they met at [REDACTED] apartment, located on Veteran's Way at approximately 2215 hours.

[REDACTED], and a friend of [REDACTED] Darren Sharper, [REDACTED] who was in town for a couple days, were all at the apartment. Sharper is a friend of [REDACTED] that lives in California and was staying in town for a few days with [REDACTED] at their apartment. [REDACTED] told me that she had not met Sharper before and believed [REDACTED] and Sharper were only friends.

Before they went out [REDACTED] mixed some Kettle One Vodka with some flavored water and had two shots chased with pineapple juice before leaving the apartment to go out. [REDACTED] stated the four of them then went to "The Mint" [REDACTED] Scottsdale, AZ. [REDACTED] advised me that they arrived at The Mint at approximately 2330 hours to meet four of Sharper's friends. [REDACTED] stated she did not know any of Sharper's friends but that one of them had a first name of Ryan and possibly a last name of [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] also believed that Ryan [REDACTED] plays for or did play for the Arizona Cardinals.

At The Mint, [REDACTED] had one drink, a vodka and soda, and spent the time there mingling with other friends. [REDACTED] claims to have not been talking to any Sharper or any of his friends. [REDACTED] was unsure of the approximate time, but the entire group of eight then left The Mint to go to another establishment, American Junkie, [REDACTED] Scottsdale, AZ. [REDACTED] stated she had one drink at American Junkie, a Ciroc and water, which she didn't finish.

[REDACTED] stated at some point while at American Junkie, [REDACTED] began acting strange. Although [REDACTED] believed they had had similar amounts of alcohol [REDACTED] was falling asleep sitting at the table and was unable to carry a conversation. [REDACTED] stated Sharper did not appear to care about [REDACTED] acting that way and that Sharper stated something similar to [REDACTED] was just excited that Sharper was in town and that she had drunk too much. [REDACTED] stated Sharper was acting like a "jerk" towards [REDACTED] and that she was concerned since Sharper was staying with [REDACTED] that she wouldn't get home safely so [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] decided to bring [REDACTED] back to her apartment. Sharper also left with them and [REDACTED] believed that they



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arrived back at the apartment around 0200 hours.

██████████ and ██████████ assisted getting ██████████ into her pajamas and helped her get into bed. ██████████ stated at this time her and ██████████ were completely coherent and felt fine but that ██████████ had also thrown up before they put her in bed.

When they were done helping ██████████ to bed, Sharper began insisting that the three of them do shots. Around this time ██████████ roommate, ██████████ woke up, ██████████ was the only other person in the apartment other than the four that had just been at the bars. ██████████ had been at work that evening and had no alcohol in her system. ██████████ and ██████████ each took one shot from Sharper that he had prepared. ██████████ thought it was possible that ██████████ took an additional half of a shot.

██████████ believed the shots were the combination of the Kettle One and pineapple juice that was still sitting out from previously that night. The mix was made in the same yellow plastic cup that ██████████ had used earlier to make shots in. She guessed the cup was approximately 16 ounces and thought the glass itself was possibly from a restaurant. The shot glasses that they were drinking out of were plastic disposable shot glasses.

██████████ stated she believed they took the shots between 0215 and 0225 hours and this is the last thing she remembers before waking up on the couch several hours later around 0835 hours.

██████████ stated when she woke up she was on the grey couch in the livingroom that is shaped like an 'L'. ██████████ believed the couch was made of a fabric material. She was on the regular part of the couch and Sharper was on the part of the couch that extends out. ██████████ told me that she was fully clothed. Both her and Sharper were covered in a grey comforter and ██████████ could not tell if Sharper was clothed or not.

██████████ stated she got up to go to the bathroom and that when she tried to check on ██████████ she found ██████████ door was locked. ██████████ thought this was strange because ██████████ does not normally lock her door and was suspicious that Sharper had gone into ██████████ bedroom and locked the door before leaving the bedroom. When she came out of the bathroom ██████████ had come out of the bedroom and Sharper had gone into ██████████ bedroom and laid down. ██████████ told ██████████ she didn't remember anything after doing the shot earlier and that she was leaving to go home.

When ██████████ got home to her parents, she went to the bathroom and she realized she felt as though she had had sexual intercourse but she hadn't had consensual sex in three and a half weeks. ██████████ stated she had pain and burning and felt raw in her vaginal area. This was the only area she



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had pain or discomfort. [REDACTED] stated this was when she began to realize that she had been sexually assaulted. [REDACTED] stated she had just had her period so there was no way "it" was from that. I did not clarify that statement.

[REDACTED] changed into shorts and a tshirt and left the clothes she had been wearing to go out in her room. [REDACTED] stated she had been wearing black leggings that were now laying on a shelf in her closet, a black tank top with the letters "LA" on it in white that was now in a dirty clothes basket, and a pair of black boots with gold clasps on them (for further information regarding exact locations see supplemental report by Officer Warbington #16819). She was currently wearing the same bra and shoes she had worn at the time of the assault and had not been wearing underwear under her leggings at the time of the assault.

[REDACTED] stated she called [REDACTED] to check on [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] was concerned that [REDACTED] had been drugged. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that she felt she had possibly been drugged after having that one shot from Sharper. [REDACTED] had not had anything else to drink that night and was very weak and disoriented after the one shot. [REDACTED] was concerned and scared enough over how she was feeling that she called her boyfriend, [REDACTED] to talk to him. [REDACTED] thought opening a window in her room and getting some air would help, but that [REDACTED] was not coordinated enough to even do that. [REDACTED] ended up locking the door to her bedroom and going to bed.

[REDACTED] then asked [REDACTED] if she was okay since she had seen Sharper on top of [REDACTED] on the couch when she went to the bathroom. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] that Sharper was naked on top of her and that she wasn't sure what was going on since [REDACTED] thought Sharper was in town to visit [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] also stated that Sharper then came and knocked on her bedroom door. Sharper told her nothing was going on with him and [REDACTED] and that [REDACTED] and him had something going on and that they were going to tell [REDACTED] in the morning (for further information from [REDACTED] regarding this incident see interview completed by Officer Milczewsky #22184).

[REDACTED] then when back to the apartment around 1155 hours to confront Sharper about what had happened. [REDACTED] was in the hallway talking with [REDACTED] and Sharper came out of the apartment. [REDACTED] stated Sharper asked her, "What happened?" and that she replied, "You tell me". Sharper acted like he didn't know what was going on and kept asking her questions about what they had been drinking and if Sharper had been throwing up. He said he didn't remember anything and wasn't making sense with the questions he was asking [REDACTED] and appeared to be "acting".

[REDACTED] reminded Sharper of the conversation they had at her bedroom



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did not say anything at the time because she was not sure what was going on and didn't know if [REDACTED] was giving him oral sex or what was going on. [REDACTED] called the Police to report what she was told. [REDACTED] did not have any further information to add regarding the investigation.

Once the interview was complete I transported [REDACTED] to Tempe Police Headquarters located at 120 E 5th Street, Tempe for an interview with Detectives. [REDACTED] father Steve met [REDACTED] at Tempe Police Headquarters as well.

[REDACTED] stated she was willing to aid in prosecution and was provided and explained victim's rights. [REDACTED] was also explained the procedure for getting an Order of Protection.

It should be noted in the beginning of my recorded interview with [REDACTED] that she began calling [REDACTED] instead of [REDACTED] as she did not know [REDACTED] well before this incident.

Officer Warbington #16819, went to [REDACTED] residence to gather the clothing she was wearing when the sexual assault occurred. [REDACTED] clothing which included: a black tank top that had 'LA' in white on it (labeled to be found in the hamper), an ASU t-shirt (labeled to be found on the bed), a black blouse (labeled to be found in the hamper), a pair of grey and pink shorts (labeled to be found on the bed), and black and white leggings, (labeled to be found hanging in the closet) were impounded with a pair of black boots, (labeled to be found on the closet floor) at the Apache Substation Locker #135. The digitally recorded interview and the initial blood test results from [REDACTED] were also impounded at Apache Substation Locker #135.

This concludes my involvement in this investigation and I have no further information at this time.

Subject:

On 11/21/13, approximately 1840 hours I was dispatched to The [REDACTED] [REDACTED] to assist in an investigation. I arrived on the scene at approximately 1842 hours and relieved Officer B. Kelly by continuing to provide scene security in front of the residence in the hallway. I observed nobody entering or exiting the door during the time I spent providing scene security from approximately 1842 to 2300 hours.

At approximately 2142 hours a security officer, identified by his drivers license as [REDACTED], approached me and said his supervisor told him to come upstairs from the lobby and tell me what he saw last night.

The following summary of his statement was recorded and impounded as evidence. [REDACTED] worked at the building providing security and last night his shift was from 2030 hours to 0430 hours.

At approximately 2100 hours [REDACTED] saw three females leave the apartment and said have a good night to them as he always did. [REDACTED] was familiar with F1 and said she had been living here at one of the apartments and would often go in and out for the last two to three months. [REDACTED] said he thought he was pretty sure he was familiar with the second and third females too but was not sure if they lived here.

He described the three females as:

F1: W/F, lng brown hair, early 20's, thin set, approx. 5'6", red shirt sleeveless, black shorts

F2: W/F, lng blond hair, early 20's, thin set, approx. 5'6", black sleeveless blouse, black/white workout tights

F3: W/F, lng blond hair, early 20's, 5'6", 120 lbs, black shirt, black/white stretchy pants with manufactured holes in the sides

[REDACTED] was seated at his security position watching cameras with the exit to the main front north side doors being just to his right when he saw the ladies depart by foot.

[REDACTED] saw these same three females come back from an unknown place and believed they returned by getting out of a green Toyota Prius Discount cab with a black male.



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██████ did not know anybody's names and described the black male who he had never seen before as:

B/M, 6'2", approx. mid 20's, approx. 250 lbs, grey shirt, blue jeans with two diamond studs in his ears.

F1 was highly intoxicated and ██████ knew she was because he could smell an odor of an intoxicating beverage coming from all four people and F1 was stumbling, gagging, dry heaving, bent over and spitting/throwing up in the outside trash can. F1 had to be helped by her female friends to get out of the cab.

When F1 came inside the main entrance doors she continued to dry heave and had to be held up by her ribs by the unknown black male who appeared to be trying to help F1 to the elevator but did not seem as if he was forcing her to do something.

██████ saw all four people enter one of the elevators then get off the elevators together on the ██████ floor by observing the security cameras. ██████ thinks the footage should be able to be reviewed for at least 3-4 days from his having to pull previous incidents recorded on camera. ██████ said he stopped watching the four individuals at about the point where they were approximately 10 feet east of apartment ██████ then he just stopped observing them because they did not look overly suspicious at the time.

██████ did not record the incident in a log because what he observed was not at all unusual for the apartment complex. This concluded ██████ statement.

This concluded my portion of the investigation.

Subject: SEXUAL ASSAULT

On 11/21/13 at 1700 hours Sgt. Kepler contacted me and advised I needed to respond to [REDACTED] - Sgt. Kepler advised one of the victims of a sexual assault had clothing she had been wearing at the time of the incident that was at her residence.

I responded to that location where I contacted [REDACTED] advised his daughter [REDACTED] informed him of what she had been wearing during the incident. [REDACTED] advised the clothing items were still in [REDACTED] room and escorted me inside.

[REDACTED] pointed out a grey ASU t-shirt and a grey pair of shorts on the bed as clothing [REDACTED] advised him she changed into after returning home. [REDACTED] pointed out a pair of black boots with gold buckles on the floor next to the closet as the shoes [REDACTED] stated she wore the night of the incident.

[REDACTED] then pointed out a pair of black and white leggings hanging from a hanger in the closet and then two black tops in [REDACTED] clothes hamper. One of the black tops was a tank top with LA in white on it and the other was a black shirt with "New York Nights LA Days" on it in white letters.

I collected all the indicated items and seized them as evidence. I took all the items to the Tempe Police Property Facility where they were placed in individual bags and secured in Temporary Evidence Locker #214.

I turned the key for the temporary evidence locker over to Ofc. Couillard and the items were later impounded as evidence.

I had no further involvement with this incident and for further refer to Ofc. Kersten's original report.

Subject: CLEAR APARTMENT/SCENE SECURITY

On 11/21/13 at approximately 2235 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] Tempe, AZ., to maintain scene security on the apartment. I took control of scene security from Officer Molina, who took over for Officer Hinz. I sat in the hallway, approximately four feet away from apartment [REDACTED] door and maintained a consistent visual on the apartment and hallway, to make sure no one went in or out of apartment [REDACTED]

I maintained scene security until Detectives arrived on scene to serve a search warrant at [REDACTED] Tempe, AZ. The apartment was locked, but we were able to get a key to unlock it from security.

Upon unlocking the door, I made several Police announcements, that we were the Police and if anyone was inside to identify themselves and come out with their hands up. No one responded and I cleared the apartment with Detectives on scene. Once the apartment was clear, I stepped outside into the hallway and maintained scene security while Detectives served the search warrant and gathered evidence.

I maintained a scene entry log from when we first entered the apartment to serve the search warrant to when we finished gathering evidence and left the apartment. I impounded the scene entry log as evidence and made a copy to send to records.

I helped transport items seized as evidence to Tempe Police Impound.

I impounded my audio recording as evidence.

This concluded my involvement in this incident.

Subject: SEXUAL ASSAULT

On 11/21/13 at approximately 1403 hours, Officer Milczewsky and I responded to the Tempe Saint Lukes Hospital located at 1500 S Mill Avenue, Tempe to assist Officer Couillard and Officer Kersten with a sexual assault call.

The comments on the call stated that a female was in the emergency room stating that she was drugged and forced to have sex. The comments indicated there was suspect information. The comments went on to say that occurred in an unknown apartment at [REDACTED] Tempe. The comments identified the victim as [REDACTED] and indicated there was another victim at the hospital.

Upon our arrival to the emergency room Officer Milczewsky and I contacted [REDACTED] while Officer Couillard and Officer Kersten contacted the other victim [REDACTED]. Both [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] were separated and interviewed in separate rooms inside the emergency room.

Officer Milczewsky later interviewed another alleged victim [REDACTED] in a separate room in the hospital while I contacted a friend of the victims in the lobby area, who identified herself as [REDACTED] and was present during portions of the incident. When asked about the incident [REDACTED] stated the following.

[REDACTED] told me that on 11/20/13 at approximately 2330 hours she, [REDACTED], [REDACTED] and Darren Sharper took an "Uber" (taxi) from the Hub located at [REDACTED] Tempe to the "Mint" in Scottsdale but they only stayed 10-15 minutes before going to "Junkie" which is also located in Scottsdale.

[REDACTED] described Sharper as being a "famous football player" but she did not know Sharper and had met him through [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] went on to say that [REDACTED] met Sharper a year ago in Las Vegas and that the two have stayed in touch with each other. When asked how she knew that it was really Darren Sharper she replied "I don't really know". [REDACTED] went on to say that she believed he was Sharper because "he has nice things" and people were coming up to him in the clubs calling him "Darren".

[REDACTED] said that they stayed at Junkie until at approximately 0139 hours at which time they left the club due to [REDACTED] "being too drunk". [REDACTED] stated that she and [REDACTED] had to carry [REDACTED] to the cab because she was extremely intoxicated. [REDACTED] said that they all took a cab from Junkie



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back to [redacted] apartment [redacted] at the [redacted] located [redacted] Tempe.

[redacted] stated that once at the apartment she and [redacted] carried [redacted] to her bedroom. [redacted] said she found it odd that Sharper did not help carry [redacted] to her bedroom because "he was suppose to be with her".

[redacted] told me that she removed [redacted] clothing and dressed her in a t-shirt and a pair of shorts. [redacted] went on to say that she left [redacted] on her bed in her bedroom sleeping.

[redacted] told me that when she came out of [redacted] bedroom Sharper had made "shots" of alcohol and was trying to get everyone to drink one.

[redacted] told me that [redacted] and [redacted] took shots but she did not. [redacted] said that approximately five minutes later she noticed that [redacted] was "passed out" on the couch in the living room. [redacted] said that they covered [redacted] with a coat and gave her a pillow. [redacted] stated that she found it odd that one shot "put her out".

[redacted] said that [redacted] was sitting in an upright position so Sharper lifted her up from the couch with his hands and laid her flat on her back. [redacted] stated that [redacted] did not even "flinch" when Sharper picked her up. [redacted] went on to say that she left the apartment at approximately 0315 hours, went to her apartment [redacted] and went to sleep. [redacted] said at that time only Sharper and [redacted] were awake, [redacted] was asleep on the couch and [redacted] was asleep in her bedroom.

[redacted] told me that she woke up at approximately 0830 hours and spoke with [redacted] on the phone. [redacted] stated that during the conversation [redacted] complained that her "vagina was sore". [redacted] went on to say that [redacted] had told her that Sharper had given her a "Molly" in the past. [redacted] explained that a "Molly" was like ecstasy or "MDMA".

[redacted] said that [redacted] and [redacted] later came to her apartment and informed her of the events that occurred at the apartment while she was gone. [redacted] stated that [redacted] believed she was sexually assaulted by Sharper and that [redacted] believed she was drugged by Sharper.

[redacted] said that at approximately 1100 hours, she, [redacted] and [redacted] were outside the apartment talking about the circumstances of the night when Sharper came outside the apartment. [redacted] told me that they confronted Sharper but he denied anything happened.

[redacted] stated that when they asked Sharper what occurred he replied "what happened? you tell me?". [redacted] said that Sharper asked, "what were we drinking?" and was avoiding the questions. [redacted] told me that she could tell that Sharper was lying. [redacted] went on to say that Sharper had a



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flight to Los Angeles at 1700 hours but he left the apartment at noon.

██████████ said at this time she, ██████████ and ██████████ went to the hospital so they could be tested to determine if ██████████ and ██████████ had been drugged by Sharper. ██████████ had nothing further to add concerning the incident. The interview with ██████████ was recorded and was later impounded as evidence.

I later accompanied Officer Milczewsky to the Family Advocate facility in Scottsdale where ██████████ received a sexual assault exam from a Forensic Nurse. After the exam was completed Officer Milczewsky and I returned to Tempe.

This concluded my involvement in the investigation. Refer to all the corresponding reports for further details concerning the incident as well as person sheets on those involved. --- Pending ---

On 11-21-13 at approximately 1403 hours, I responded to Tempe St. Luke's Hospital to assist Officer E. Kersten with a rape investigation. Comments to the call stated a female victim was drugged and forced to have sex. She was at the hospital with another female who was present during the alleged incident.

I interviewed two victims, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] individually in separate rooms. [REDACTED] identified herself with her CA driver's license and reported the following.

[REDACTED] lives at [REDACTED] Tempe, AZ with her roommate, [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] told her yesterday (11-20-13) that her friend, Darren Sharper was coming to visit her and would spend the night at their apartment. [REDACTED] stated that was fine and she went to work.

[REDACTED] came home from work around 2300 hours and went to sleep. She reported that [REDACTED] Sharper and two of [REDACTED] friends, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] came home around 0230 hours and woke her up because they were being loud. [REDACTED] reported [REDACTED] was very drunk and they had to help her get to bed due to the level of her impairment. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] appeared completely sober when they got home. Sharper appeared like he had a few drinks, but did not appear drunk. She reported that he was very polite, conversational, and wanted to hang out and have more drinks with them.

After they put [REDACTED] to bed, [REDACTED] said she was going to her apartment to sleep, and Sharper began protesting and asking them to stay up and keep hanging out with him. He started making drinks in the corner and made shots. He insisted that they had to take them since he made them. She believes they were made with Kettle One vodka and some kind of fruit juice mix, possibly raspberry. She does not know if Sharper brought the alcohol or if it was already in the apartment.

[REDACTED] and Sharper all drank the shots made by Sharper. [REDACTED] was the only one who did not take the shot. [REDACTED] reported that [REDACTED] sat down on the couch right after she took the shot and fell asleep right away. [REDACTED] stated she thought it was very odd that [REDACTED] became so incapacitated after one shot because she appeared completely sober before she took it.



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She reported that Sharper picked [REDACTED] up to lay her down in the corner of the couch, and [REDACTED] observed [REDACTED] to be completely limp as Sharper picked her up. [REDACTED] stated they should give [REDACTED] a pillow and a blanket. They found a pillow but did not have a blanket, so they covered her with a jacket. [REDACTED] left at that point and went to her own apartment in the same building. [REDACTED] stated she also was going to go to sleep, but Sharp [REDACTED] insisted that she take at least another half of a shot with him. [REDACTED] agreed, but said she is going to sleep after that. She drank another half of a shot that Sharper made and went to her room to go to sleep.

[REDACTED] called her boyfriend [REDACTED] after she went to her room, and he advised her to lock her door since she does not know Sharper and he is a stranger. [REDACTED] stated she laid down in bed and all of a sudden began to feel very weird physically. She said she got scared and started to cry. Her boyfriend suggested that she open the window to get some fresh air, and she struggled to get out of bed and open the window.

She reported her muscles felt very heavy and weak. She also felt dizzy, felt like the room was spinning, and she found it difficult to speak. [REDACTED] stated she did not feel like she was drunk, but she felt "drugged." She reported that she has drank alcohol and has been drunk in the past, and this did not feel the same. She reported it was not normal for her to become this incapacitated after only drinking one and a half shots of alcohol.

[REDACTED] continued talking on the phone with her boyfriend, asking what she should do because she was scared about what she was experiencing physically. Her boyfriend told her to go splash some cold water on her face. [REDACTED] came out of her room to go to the bathroom, and at time she observed Sharper naked, crouched over [REDACTED] who was laying on the couch, and said Sharper was having sex with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] stated she was taken back by what she saw and stood there for a while wondering if she should intervene. She reported being concerned that the sexual act was not consensual because she did not know if [REDACTED] was awake. She went to the bathroom and wondered what to do, but was afraid to intervene because she does not know Sharper, and because he is a big guy and she did not know if he would become violent or how he would react.

[REDACTED] went back to her room and locked the door. She was still on the phone with her boyfriend when Sharper knocked on her bedroom door. She was afraid to open the door, but her boyfriend advised her to stay on the phone with him while she opens it, and if he hears anything concerning he will call for help. [REDACTED] opened the door and Sharper stated to her, "Hey,



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about that right there, [REDACTED] and I are just friends, but me and that girl (referring to [REDACTED] have something going on, we are going to tell [REDACTED] in the morning." [REDACTED] stated she did not know what to say and thought that was a very weird thing for Sharper to say. She said "OK" and closed her door.

She was in her room when she heard Sharper go into the bathroom. [REDACTED] came out and tried to wake [REDACTED] up, pulling on her arm and telling her to come lay in her bed, but [REDACTED] was still not responsive. She reported that [REDACTED] was clothed when she tried to wake her up. [REDACTED] stated she went to [REDACTED] room to try to find her cell phone and call [REDACTED] to come help, as [REDACTED] was the only one sober. [REDACTED] stated she does not know [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] well, as they are [REDACTED] friends and [REDACTED] just met them recently and did not have their phone numbers. She was unable to find [REDACTED] phone and went back to her room and went to sleep.

When [REDACTED] woke up the next morning around 1000 hours, she still felt weird physically and did not want to be in the apartment with Sharper still being there. She reported that Sharper was asleep on the couch when she left. [REDACTED] bedroom door was locked, which she thought was strange because the door was open all night and [REDACTED] was passed out.

[REDACTED] left her apartment and went to a friend's apartment. She contacted [REDACTED] via Facebook as she did not have her phone number, to check on her. She asked [REDACTED] if she was OK about what happened the night before, and asked [REDACTED] if she had sex with Sharper. [REDACTED] told her she did not have sex with Sharper, but felt physically like something had happened to her. [REDACTED] told [REDACTED] to call her, and told her about what she witnessed last night. [REDACTED] stated she was going to go get a "rape kit," but she first wanted to confront Sharper.

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] met at [REDACTED] apartment and went to [REDACTED] apartment to confront Sharper. [REDACTED] was in the apartment with Sharper. [REDACTED] was afraid to confront Sharper inside, so they asked him to step outside into the hallway. [REDACTED] asked Sharper what happened last night, and he responded that he did not remember, and asked them what they all had to drink last night. [REDACTED] confronted Sharper about what he said to her when he knocked on her bedroom door, after she observed him having sex with [REDACTED] and Sharper denied ever speaking with [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] and [REDACTED] went to Tempe St. Luke's hospital to be examined. While at the hospital, [REDACTED] sent [REDACTED] a text message, telling her to get Sharper out of their apartment. [REDACTED] responded that he is already gone. [REDACTED] reported that Sharper reportedly is taking a flight back to LA at 1700 hours today, but did not know on what airline.



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██████████ stated she wants to aid in prosecution for being drugged by Sharper. My interview with ██████████ was audio recorded and the recording was impounded as evidence at 1875 E Apache Blvd.

██████████ arrived at the hospital with ██████████. I interviewed ██████████ while Officer M. Vick interviewed ██████████. See Officer M. Vick's supplement report for information regarding his interview with ██████████.

██████████ identified herself with her AZ driver's license. I asked ██████████ to tell me what and why she was here at the hospital today, and she responded, "I guess I got raped, maybe drugged, I think, I don't know." ██████████ appeared uncomfortable, she was avoiding eye contact by looking around the room. ██████████ reported the following about her relationship with Sharper and what she believes occurred last night.

██████████ met Sharper in Las Vegas approximately one year ago. The two of them maintained contact via phone and text message, and saw each other occasionally. ██████████ reported they were not dating, but had a sexual relationship. She reported Sharper flew in to Phoenix yesterday to visit her and a few other friends he has in town, and she picked him up from the airport around 2130 hours.

██████████ reported she, Sharper, ██████████ and ██████████ went out to the American Junkie bar in Scottsdale, AZ. ██████████ remembers having approximately four drinks while at the bar, and becoming very incapacitated. She reported that she has never felt this drunk before after having four drinks. She stated that she could not walk or talk, and her friends carried her out of the bar to the cab.

She stated she remembers them asking her if she was alright as they carried her out of the bar, but does not remember anything after that. She did not remember getting to her apartment building or going in the elevator. She felt like she "wasn't even a person, and they had to do everything for me." She reported that her friends told her the next day that they changed her into her pajamas and put her to bed.

██████████ woke up this morning around 0830 hours in her bed, and found that she was naked from the waste down. She also was laying sideways in her bed. She got out of bed and saw her underwear and blue pajama shorts laying on the floor next to her bed and she was only wearing her pajama shirt. She reported these were the same shorts that her friends told her they put on her when they put her to bed the night before. ██████████ also reported that her bedroom door was locked a different way than how she locks it.

She explained and demonstrated on the door of the room we were in, that she



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only pushes the lock in when inside her room, but does not turn it. She reported this locks the door, but it disengages the lock when she pulls down the handle from the inside to open the door. She only locks it this way to prevent accidentally locking herself out of her room if she was to shut the door from the outside.

██████████ reported she came out of her room after she woke up at 0830 and saw Sharper and ██████████ sleeping on the couch. ██████████ went back to sleep and woke up again around noon. She stated she was still wondering why her shorts and underwear were off and on the floor. Her friends then started calling her and ██████████ told her she thinks she was raped. ██████████ and ██████████ came to her apartment and met in the hallway to talk about what happened.

They then asked Sharper what happened last night and he said he did not remember. ██████████ stayed in her apartment with Sharper while the other girls left to go to the hospital. She stated Sharper left her apartment shortly after. I asked how he left and where he went, and she reported that she dropped him off at the Breakfast Club restaurant where his friends picked him up.

██████████ reported Sharper was flying back to LA today. She does not know where he lives in LA, but believes he is living in a hotel because he has a house in Miami, FL, but is staying in LA currently for work.

I asked ██████████ why she thinks she was raped. She stated that it is because she woke up naked from the waste down and ██████████ told her that they did dress her in the blue shorts that were next to her bed when she woke up. She stated she also feels physically like she definitely had sex last night. I asked ██████████ if she and Sharper had sex yesterday after she picked him up and before she became intoxicated, and she denied.

██████████ then reported that while she was driving Sharper to drop him off at the Breakfast Club, she continued to ask why the other girls would all say that something happened. She reported that Sharper finally stated, "I don't really remember, I guess I could have done that, I'm really sorry." ██████████ clarified that he was referring to having sex with ██████████ and with her when he said that.

██████████ agreed to having a forensic exam. She was not sure whether or not she wanted to aid in prosecution. My interview with ██████████ was audio recorded and the recording was impounded as evidence at 1875 E Apache Blvd.

██████████ was transported to the Scottsdale Family Advocacy Center via Care 7 for the forensic medical exam. I followed the Care 7 van from St. Luke's hospital to the advocacy center, maintaining a visual on them the entire



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time.

The exam on [REDACTED] was performed by a forensic nurse, Sandra Salomon. Salomon reported that she did not find any visible signs of trauma and could not conclude based on visual exam whether or not [REDACTED] engaged in sexual contact last night. Swabs were collected to test for physical evidence, however the results were not available at the time of this report.

[REDACTED] was transported from the advocacy center to the Tempe Police Headquarters office by her mother, for an interview with the detectives.

This concluded my involvement in this investigation. For further details regarding the interview with the third victim, [REDACTED] see Officer E. Kersten original report.
