

RESTART PLAN CONCERNS

A. Classrooms, Testing, Therapy Rooms

- No AC at Piners. AC did not work at LMS 9/1 and at Oak 9/2.
All A/C Units are currently working.
- Maintenance worker at EGC 9/2/20 told staff member that every building has a ventilation system that have fans on each roof. Those fans, to his knowledge haven't been maintained. When inspections were done, recommendations were made for improvement. Water system should have been flushed and mold and air quality inspection should have been done.
Please provide name of the “maintenance worker,” so an investigation can be conducted into this allegation.
- Staff have to walk through isolation room to get to their office.
Please provide the name of the school, so an investigation can be conducted.
- Not all staff received cleaning supplies and/or cloths/paper towels.
Please provide the name of the school and date, so an investigation can be conducted.
- Classrooms still dirty from last year. Clearly have not been cleaned or sanitized – glue on desks, boards still have writing on them.
Do custodians clean blackboards? Please provide all classroom numbers and school names so an investigation can be conducted.
- Mixing of cohorts – Substitutes, ICS teachers, Special Area teachers as well as Administrators for instructional purposes, covering classes, and/or lunches. **As per the plan, cohorts are created, to the best extent possible.**
- Superintendent states on 9/1/2020 to LEA that classes across elementary schools were not over 20. Many classes, however, have over 20 students and not just in the middle school. **Please provide a list of any classes over 20, after Remote Instruction students were removed, so an investigation can be conducted.**
- Plexiglass is sharp and unstable. Staff have already been cut or scratched on it.
Over the weekend, the Vendor rounded out the corners of the Plexiglas at each of the schools.
- Not all rooms have plexiglass. **All schools were completed over the weekend.**
- Tables in classrooms, used for small group instruction which is required in the plan, do not have plexiglass.
Small room instruction tables will not be receiving plexi, as the students will not be sitting six feet apart.

The recommendation is for student to utilize their desks, which have plexi on them and for the teacher to have them gather their desks in a group. The teacher can wear his/her shield for added protection.

C. Student Flow, Entry, Exit, Common Areas

- Temperature checks are time consuming, 30 minutes at Spruce 9/1, 40 minutes LHS.
As expected on the first day. This was due to the fact that students/parents did not have their schedules and could not access the parent portal.
- All schools do not have social distancing markings installed in hallways.
What schools, and which markers?
- Mixing of cohorts – Substitutes, ICS teachers, Special Area teachers as well as Administrators for instructional purposes, covering classes, and/or lunches. **This question was answered above.**
- Superintendent states on 9/1/2020 to LEA that classes across elementary schools were not to be over 20. Many classes, however, have over 20 students, and not just in the middle school. **This question was answered above.**

D. Screening, PPE, Response to Students and Staff Presenting Symptoms

- Not all staff has received masks and/or face shields.
I was notified over the weekend from HS staff and Spruce Staff that they did not receive their face coverings. In speaking with both Principals, the face coverings were put in their mailboxes. Any staff who did not receive their face coverings or shields should immediately see their Principals.
- Plexiglass staff in buildings without masks. **This issue was addressed with the Vendor, and will NOT happen again.**
- Security not properly wearing masks.
What security specialist, so that an investigation can be conducted?
- Face shields are disposable but staff only received one.
Face shields are not disposable, they are to be cleaned. Should they break, ask for another one.

- Empty soap dispensers.
See your building custodian.
- Physical education teachers only given one bottle of cleaner to use among 4 teachers to wipe down equipment.
See your building custodian.

E. Contact Tracing

- Nurses told not to report positive cases to Department of Health.
Nurses were told to report positive cases to their Supervisor Devorie Stareshefsky and Superintendent who will report the positive cases to the Department of Health.

F. Facilities Cleaning Practices

- Touch points not being wiped down.
Will follow-up with Aramark.
- No wipes for technology (computers, printers, headphones).
The district will be distributing technology wipes.
- Not all staff received cleaning supplies and/or cloths/paper towels. **All rooms should have cleaning supplies and paper towels. Many schools had teachers sign them out in the main office of the school.**
- Bathrooms not cleaned (logs not filled in). **Will follow up with Aramark.**
- Custodians setting alarm at 4:30, even though staff has been in building all day, without deep cleaning. **Will follow up with Aramark.**
- Garbage not emptied and overflowing at OSS, toilet paper not replaced. **Will follow up with Aramark.**
- Physical education teachers only given one bottle of cleaner to use among 4 teachers to wipe down equipment. **This question was answered above.**

G. Meals

- No space for staff to each lunch and/or do work during Prep either inside or outside.

All schools have a designated area inside and outside. Please provide the name of the school in order to investigate.

- LHS students eating breakfast in classroom, but some classrooms do not have windows.
Will speak to the Principals about changing the rooms that do not have windows.
- Teachers tasked with wiping down dividers between meals.
Teachers have not been asked to wipe down Plexiglas dividers. All schools were tasked with given Aramark a cleaning schedule.

H. Recess/PE

- Physical education teachers only given one bottle of cleaner to use among 4 teachers to wipe down equipment. **Repeated question**
- Physical education teachers tasked with wiping down equipment **They can give Aramark a cleaning schedule if there is "equipment" that needs to be cleaned.**

I. General Health and Safety Guidelines

- All staff meetings to be held remotely according to plan, as well as IEP & IR&S meeting. CST summoned to HS on Wednesday, 9/2/20 for meeting. Some had masks, some didn't. Social distancing not necessarily observed. Presenter presented without mask, Board Attorney had mask below nose. Plan states staff must wear masks at all times except when eating. **Will Review.**
- Dirty mask removed from table by custodian & mask was thrown away but area was not cleaned.
- See all above. **Will Review procedures with Aramark.**
