Corbett, N.Y. – Today, Sheriff Craig S. DuMond announced that a New Jersey fugitive was arrested Saturday afternoon following an incident in the Town of Colchester.

Late Saturday afternoon, June 19, 2021, Sheriff's Deputies responded to a report of a vehicle in the East Branch Delaware River near the Corbett bridge.

Investigation revealed that a New Jersey couple were attempting to drive their Toyota Tacoma pickup across the river when it became partially submerged and disabled in deep water. Further investigation revealed that one of the vehicle occupants, 30 year-old Brian P. Olin, of Lavallette, N.J., was wanted by in Hunterdon County, New Jersey, on an outstanding warrant for failure to appear in court on a felony drug charge in September, 2019.

Olin was subsequently arrested and charged with being a fugitive from justice and was later arraigned and remanded to the Delaware County Correctional Facility to be held without bail pending his extradition by New Jersey law enforcement authorities.
