Pop-up COVID Clinics in Delaware County

Delaware County is 1 of 6 counties in New York State chosen to receive support from NYSDOH to conduct COVID vaccination clinics. Personnel from NYSDOH and the national guard will support the county operated clinics beginning January 7, 2022.

The first location will be held in Sidney at the Sidney Elks Lodge, 104 River St. from 11AM-7PM, on Friday January 7th, 8th, 28th, and 29th.

The second in Stamford at the Catskill Veterans Outreach Center, 56 Main St. from 11AM-7PM, on January 14th, 15th, February 4th and 5th.

The third location in Hancock at the Hancock Central School Bus Garage, 619 West Main St., Hancock, NY, from 11AM-7PM on January 21st, 22nd, February 11th and 12th.

We are excited to work with the NYSDOH and community partners to conduct vaccination clinics in pop-up locations in Delaware County. The initial clinic at each location will be returned to three weeks later to the same location for individuals receiving their 1st dose and 2nd doses of vaccine.

Online pre-registration links will be available next week. Walk-in appointments are also accepted for all eligible individuals.

Vaccines available at all sites include: Pfizer 5-11; Pfizer 12 and older (first, second, Third and booster); and Janssen/J&J (Primary and Booster). All individuals 5 years of age and older that reside in the United States are eligible to receive the vaccine.

Teens 16-17 years old who received their Pfizer-BioNTech initial vaccine series at least six months ago are eligible for the Pfizer-BioNTech booster.

New Yorkers 18 years and older who received the Pfizer-BioNTech or Moderna initial vaccine series at least six months ago or the Janssen/Johnson & Johnson vaccine at least two months ago are eligible for their booster dose. CDC and NYSDOH encourage eligible New Yorkers to get their booster dose, especially those over the age of 50 and others with underlying conditions.

Children 5 – 11 are also eligible for the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine.
