44	Scarborough	3/12 – 3/16	Northbound (east) of the plaza; lane closures from 6:00 am to 4:30 pm. Speeds are reduced to 45 mph.
44	Scarborough	3/13- 3/14	Southbound lane closures at Exit 44 entering ramp from 8:30 am to 2:30 pm. Speeds are reduced to 50 mph.
46	South Portland	3/14 – 3/15	Northbound lane closures from 8:00 pm to 6:00 am. Speeds are reduced to 50 mph.
