Household Trash & Junk

Brush & Yard Waste: limited to 2 pickup truck loads of brush per resident. Yard waste in Kraft bags only no plastic bags. No trailer loads.

Appliances: freezers, refrigerators, and air conditioners must have the compressor removed.

<u>Computers:</u> including monitors, computer towers (CPU's), keyboard, mice and printers will be accepted.

Recycling: scrap metal, cardboard to include cereal and soda boxes, aluminum cans, newspaper with the inserts, office paper (including magazines), steel cans, and plastics #1-#7. No plastic bags!

<u>Cooking Oil</u>: Cooking oil will be accepted. Cooking oil must be verified by Solid Waste personnel.



**No Construction Debris—No Exceptions

TIRES: 2EA FREE TIRES WITHOUT RIMS WILL BE ALLOWED PER-HOUSEHOLD – ANY MORE WILL BE CHARGED AT THE REGULAR PRICE OF \$3 PER TIRE FOR 17" AND BELOW, OR \$7 PER TIRE FOR 17.5" AND ABOVE. AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF \$20 APPLIES IF RIMS ARE LEFT ON THE TIRE.
