III. OUTREACH INITIATIVES

No.	Type of Outreach Initiative	Brief Description of Activity
1	Internship program	The Station offers internships in all departments at its radio stations, including promotions, sales, production and programming. The internships continue at varying lengths throughout the calendar year. The interns come from a variety of sources, but most are referred to WFHN/WBSM through the New Bedford Chamber of Commerce, Wareham High School and Greater New Bedford Vocational Technical. Information about the internship program is posted on the stations' web sites and distributed through on-air announcements. Most interns are college students and receive college credit for the internships. The Program Director oversees the interns, evaluating their performance and ensuring that they receive the necessary training and education to excel in their position and gain experience in broadcasting. During the reporting period, the Employment Unit had seven interns. Dates Include: 3/5/21-5/30/21, 2 interns, five days weekly 10/1/21-11/30/21, 1 intern, 3 days per week
2	Participated in job fair	TSM New Bedford participated in the Virtual Job Fair hosted by the Massachusetts Broadcasters Association from 4/23 – 4/27 where over the course of the week period potential candidates could learn more about working at Townsquare Media New Bedford, the types of opportunities available in promotions, sales and programming. Potential candidates contacted the Market President with questions and inquiries about the positions available.
3	Participated in other activities designed to disseminate information as to employment opportunities in broadcasting to job candidates who might otherwise be unaware of such opportunities	WBSM-AM hosts a weekly public affairs program that airs on Sundays at 6am. Market President was on the show on 10/31/21 to talk about opportunities available in broadcasting and how a local broadcaster like WBSM operates in and supports the community
4	Co-sponsored job fair	TSM New Bedford co-sponsored the Southcoast Chamber of Commerce Job Fair on September 15, 2021 at Whites in Westport. We promoted the event with over 100 no charge mentions and broadcasted from the event the day of to help with attendance. There were over 100 booths including one from TSM where we recruited for full time on-air and support positions. On-air talent/promotions coordinator was there talking to potential promotions candidates. Senior Account Executive was at the event talking to potential sales candidates about a career at Townsquare Media.
