COMPLAINT

Order of Detention

Amended

The Complainant submits this complaint to the Court and states that there is probable cause to believe Defendant committed the following offense(s):

COUNT I

Charge: Assault in the Second Degree

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.222.1, 609.11.5(a)

Maximum Sentence: 3 to 7 years, \$14,000 fine or both (MSG SL 6)

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/03/2019

Control #(ICR#): 19054282

Charge Description: On or about November 3, 2019, within the County of Olmsted, Abdusalam Omar Hussein did wrongfully, unlawfully and feloniously assault another, to-wit: Victim #1, with a dangerous weapon, to-wit: handgun.

COUNT II

Charge: Assault in the Second Degree

Minnesota Statute: 609.222.1, with reference to: 609.222.1, 609.11.5(a)

Maximum Sentence: 3 to 7 years, \$14,000 fine or both (MSG SL 6)

Offense Level: Felony

Offense Date (on or about): 11/03/2019

Control #(ICR#): 19054282

Charge Description: On or about November 3, 2019, within the County of Olmsted, Abdusalam Omar Hussein did wrongfully, unlawfully and feloniously assault another, to-wit: Victim #2, with a dangerous weapon, to-wit: handgun.

STATEMENT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

The Complainant states that the following facts establish probable cause:

Your complainant is a licensed peace officer employed by the Rochester Police Department. In that capacity your Complainant has reviewed the police reports relating to Abdusalam Omar Hussein, the above-named defendant, and the allegations contained therein. Based upon that information, your complainant believes the following to be true and correct.

On November 3, 2019 at about 0632 hours, the Rochester Police Department received a 911 call reporting that a male had been shot at a multi-unit residential building in southeast Rochester, Olmsted County, Minnesota. When officers arrived, they found an adult male (hereinafter "Victim #1") in the house. Victim #1 had been shot four times in the legs and once in the hand. He was transported to St Mary's Hospital for injuries that are not expected to be life threatening.

Officer Hilowle interviewed Victim #1 at the hospital. He said that he was sleeping in bed, when someone walked into his unlocked residence. The person, who is a male he knows as "Dream" shot him multiple times. According to Victim #1, the suspect came into Victim #1's room and started kicking Victim #1. The suspect was also waving a handgun around. The suspect then started shooting at Victim #1's legs. There was little motive given for the shooting, other than that the suspect was described as intoxicated. Officer Hilowle learned that Victim #1 had been shot five times in the lower extremities and one round grazed Victim #1's index finger.

Officers knew "Dream" to be a street name associated with ABDUSALAM OMAR HUSSEIN (DOB 1/1/81). Inv. Lodermeier prepared a photo lineup that included HUSSEIN's photograph and Victim #1 identified HUSSEIN as the shooter.

At approximately 6:35 a.m., an adult male (hereinafter "Victim #2") arrived for work at a convenience store on 37th Street NW in Rochester. Victim #2 was early for work and stayed in his car in the parking lot. As Victim #2 was seated in his car, a red minivan pulled up next to him; the red minivan was so close to Victim #2 driver's door that Victim #2 could not open the door. Victim #2 rolled down his window thinking that the driver of the red minivan needed something. After asking Victim #2 if he could have a dollar, the driver of the red minivan pulled out a gun and pointed it at Victim #2. When Victim #2 started to roll up his window, the suspect told Victim #2, "you are a dead person" and that he would shoot Victim #2. The suspect stated that he had just shot someone "on the south side" and did not want to go to jail. Victim #2 begged for his life and the suspect left eventually. When shown a photo lineup by Inv. Lodermeier, Victim #2 identified HUSSEIN as the person who pointed the gun at him.

At about 0719 hours, the shooting suspect called 911. He said that he was a child soldier suffering from a mental issue, and that someone made him do it. He said that he had a gun with him, but it was unloaded.

Officers were able to track the suspect's cell phone, and they attempted to pull him over on Highway 52 north of 55th Street NW. The suspect called dispatch and said that he was not stopping and would shoot police. With officers in pursuit, the suspect turned sharply into the ditch on White Bridge Road NE. HUSSEIN's vehicle rolled and he was initially trapped inside. Officers broke the rear window and HUSSEIN crawled out of the vehicle. Sgt. Bormann of the Minnesota State Patrol recovered a semi-automatic Beretta handgun from HUSSEIN.

During a custodial interview with Sgt. Thompson, HUSSEIN admitted to shooting Victim #1. According to

HUSSEIN, he “put him in a wheelchair.” HUSSEIN also stated that red minivan he used to drive away was stolen.
