

What's in the Name?



Each suggested name for the Amphitheater has some meaning. So below is some additional information, which might help you pick your favorite name.

THE LEDGE AMPHITHEATER OR THE LEDGE: With the many rock ledges that exist throughout the property, the name “The Ledge” seems appropriate to be considered for such a unique site. The Ledge also means legend or legendary and also describes the Amphitheater site well, as no other outdoor amphitheater site will have this distinct setting for such a venue.

TRANSFORMER AMPHITHEATER: The large quarry located on the Amphitheater site was once mined by Martin Marietta. The name of this quarry was Transformer Quarry, which is where the name “Transformer Amphitheater” originates from. The transformation of this site from an old abandoned quarry, to an outdoor amphitheater intended to draw 60,000-80,000 attendees each year, is truly a sight to be seen!



BEDROCK AMPHITHEATER: While a play on the Flintstones, the name “Bedrock Amphitheater” comes from the bedrock that exists above ground and underground at the Amphitheater site, as well as, many other properties in Waite Park. The bedrock is used throughout the site, making this amphitheater a unique venue for many to enjoy in the years to come.



THE GEM AMPHITHEATER or THE GEM: With a gem being considered a precious stone, the Amphitheater site has also been seen as a precious piece of property with many stones/rocks that make the site so beautiful and unique. This property has often been referred to as the hidden “Gem”, since most people have been unaware of this valuable property which has now been revealed in the heart of the Waite Park community.

SKYVIEW AMPHITHEATER: With the amphitheater being a beautiful outdoor venue, the open views of the sky will be remarkable for all to see. The name “Skyview Amphitheater” says it all!
