		The SEU's Promotions Department and Promotions Coordinator are in contact with internship representatives from Marist College, Suny New Paltz, Dutchess Community College, Vassar College, Orange County Community College, Sullivan County Community College, Brooklyn College, and Mount Saint Mary's College on a regular basis and work hard to develop these relationships for the benefit of the students as well as the SEU's internship program.
		The SEU had three hiring sessions during the reporting period. Specifically, during the period of (2/1/22-5/7/22) the SEU hosted 6 interns from Marist College, and SUNY New Paltz; during the period of (6/5/22-8/11/22) the SEU hosted 1 intern from Marist College; and during the period of (9/17/22-12/9/22) the SEU hosted 1 intern Marist College.
		All interns are required to work 12 hours per week. The interns work in the SEU's Promotions and Programming Department under the supervision of the SEU's Promotions Director and Promotions Coordinator. Typical duties include doing research projects about the specific departments and roles at a media company, conducting research and developing their own stories, assisting with script writing, collecting marketing data, participating in on-site events, shadowing full-time employees to learn about their positions, and completing projects so they can leave the internship with an entire portfolio of items to help them obtain employment in the field.
