His presentation ended with a Q&A session, giving the students an opportunity to ask the Chief Meteorologist questions about his career.

Event 4: WKXW-FM NJ101.5 and WPST-FM 94.5's Chief Meteorologist participated as an invited guest speaker it a third-grade class at the Frank K. Hehnly Elementary School in Clark, New Jersey on Tuesday, April 9, 2024. According to school officials, approximately 300 students from 18 New Jersey high schools were in attendance for the daylong event. The event was the cumulation of a fiveday film challenge that ran from Monday, April 15, 2024 through Friday, April 19, 2024. The workshop and awards presentation ran from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Friday, May 17, 2024. As an invited guest speaker, the Chief Meteorologist led a 60-minute presentation titled "The Rule of Three: A New Way to Think about Content Creation, Job Searching, and More." During the presentation, the Chief Meteorologist discussed the natural psychology of organizing information into groups of three, and then showed how that can apply to efficient and effective content creation and career development. The last segment of his talk specifically covered the career opportunities in radio and television.

Event 7: A WKXW-FM NJ101.5 Digital Journalist virtually spoke to a group of students in a production radio course, COM-105, at Bergen Community College in Paramus, New Jersey on Thursday, September 12, 2024. The 45-minute presentation was held via Webex with 15 students in attendance. To prepare students for their class assignment to create and deliver a newscast, the Digital Journalist discussed the steps involved. He discussed with students the importance of using reliable sources; the

pitfalls of using social media as the only source for a news story; and the important role of media organizations to report on the facts. Students were encouraged to ask questions during the presentation, with most of them wanting to know about the Digital Journalist's career experiences.

Event 8: Two employees representing WKXW-FM NJ101.5 and WPST-FM 94.5, the Vice President of Sales and a Regional Traffic and Continuity Manager, were invited guest speakers for a radio production course, COM-105, at Bergen Community College in Paramus, New Jersey on Thursday, September 26, 2024. As part of the course curriculum, the two employees helped prepare students for their latest course assignment, "Creating a Client Commercial." During the discussion, the Vice Present of Sales and the Regional Traffic and Continuity Manager explained how a commercial spot is sold; the differences and similarities between terrestrial and digital advertising; the importance of effective copy and sonic branding; the process of writing and producing commercials for radio; and the procedures for scheduling commercials for air. Students engaged in a Q&A at the end, asking the two employees various questions, including their career experiences. Ten students participated in the discussion.

Event 9: On Wednesday, October 23, 2024, five students from an "Announcing for Media" class at Mercer County Community College in West Windsor, New Jersey visited the studios of WKXW-FM NJ101.5 and WPST-FM 94.5. The students arrived at 1:30 p.m. and departed at 2:40 p.m. The group toured the stations' facilities; observed WKXW-FM NJ101.5's the "Dennis and Judi Show" for approximately 25 minutes; and got a tutorial from WPST-FM 94.5's Brand Manager about how the station's Top 40 format operates. Additionally, students observed a live, anchored newscast on

Students also had the opportunity to speak with WKXW-FM NJ 101.5's Digital Managing Editor and a Digital News Reporter about the importance of learning to write articles for a website. During the visit, students were encouraged to ask questions about career and internship opportunities at the station unit and throughout the broadcasting industry.

Event 10: Ten students from Bordentown Regional Middle School visited the studios of WKXW-FM NJ101.5 and WPST-FM 94.5 on December 10, 2024. The students were part of Bordentown Regional Middle School's Extended Learning Program for the Academically Talented (ELPAT). As part of the ELPAT program, the students were working on a project to create a 10-minute newscast. During the 60minute visit that started at 10:30 a.m., students observed and participated in WKXW-FM NJ101.5's the "Dennis and Judi Show;" talked with two On-Air Content Creators and the Brand Manager of WPST-FM 94.5 about preparing for a morning show on a Top 40 format, handling sensitive topics, and how the clocks/logs work for the station; and observed a live, anchored newscast on WKXW-FM NJ101.5. Additionally, students had the opportunity to speak for 30 minutes to members of the WKXW-FM NJ101.5 newsroom, including the News Director and a News Anchor and Reporter. The news personnel discussed the skills needed to anchor a newscast; how it is determined what stories will be covered on a given day; and the standards the department follows when writing newscasts and articles. Students asked the News Director and News Anchor and Reporter how to get started in a broadcasting career and what type of college courses are important to take for a journalism career. Students were encouraged to ask questions throughout the visit.

Event 11: The Promotions Coordinator for WKXW-FM NJ101.5 and WPST 94.5 was an invited guest speaker during a radio production course, COM-105, at Bergen Community College in Paramus, New Jersey on Thursday, December 12, 2024. The 60minute virtual presentation was centered around the functions of the marketing and promotions department at the station unit. During his conversation, the Promotions Coordinator talked about what happens in week-to-week operations. The Promotions Coordinator also gave advice to students about working in the radio industry, including tips and tricks to help students in their career path. Students were encouraged to come prepared with questions. Seven students were present for the discussion.

Event 12: On Thursday, January 23, 2025, a WKXW-FM NJ101.5 Digital Journalist virtually spoke to a group of students in a production radio course, COM-105, at Bergen Community College in Paramus, New Jersey. Thirteen students were present for the 60-minute presentation that was held via Webex. To prepare students for their class assignment to create and deliver a newscast, the Digital Journalist discussed the steps involved. He talked about story selection and how students can determine what is considered a lead story versus what is a kicker. The Digital Journalist also talked about the importance of using reliable sources; the risks of relying on social media when reporting on a story; and the critical role media organizations play in reporting the facts about a particular issue. He also discussed that while some broadcast outlets are struggling, there will always be a need for journalists, audio producers, and content producers. Students were permitted to ask the Digital Journalist questions throughout the presentation.
